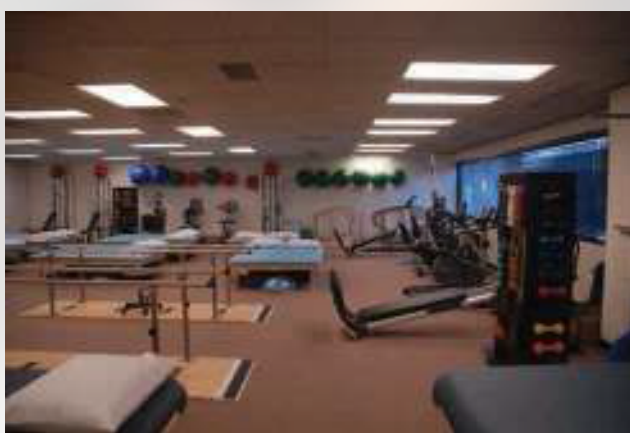

## PTA Program Details at CBD College

- The PTA program at CBD College is designed to prepare students for a career in physical therapy. Students will learn anatomy and physiology, kinesiology, physical therapy procedures, pediatric, adult, and geriatric principals, neurological, sports injuries, and orthopedics techniques, documentation principals and skills, interpersonal communications skills, modalities and electric stimulation, rehabilitation principals, personal and professional ethics, and integumentary and wound care principals. Clinical experience and direct patient contact occurs in the last module of the program.
- The program is divided into five modules. General education courses occur in the first module and PTA core classes are covered in the other four modules. The first clinical experience is in module #4 for two weeks and module #5 is entirely clinical practical experience. Students will be under the supervision of a PT professional during clinical rotations.
