OTA Program Details at CBD College

- The OTA program at CBD College is designed to fully prepare students for work in the allied health field as an OTA under the supervision of, and in partnership with, the Occupational Therapist. Students will learn to implement rehabilitative interventions outlined by an OT treatment plan or contribute to the modification of the treatment plan by exchanging information about the patient's progress to the occupational therapist. Graduates of the OTA program will be able to sit for the national certification exam offered by the National Board for Certification in Occupational Therapy (NBCOT). After successful completion of the exam, the individual will be a Certified Occupational Therapy Assistant (COTA).
- The program is divided into five modules. General education courses occur in the first module and OTA core classes are covered in the other four modules. The first field work experience is in module #4 for two weeks and module #5 is entirely field work experience. Students will be under an supervision of an OT professional during clinical rotations.
